The St. Therese, the Little Flower Scholarship

The St. Therese, the Little Flower Scholarship is a \$2,500 tuition scholarship available to current McAuley students of all levels. Four scholarships will be awarded each year, one to a student in each class level. The scholarship was established by the family of McAuley alumnae in order to support current students in their pursuit of a Mother McAuley High School education. **APPLICATIONS ARE DUE MONDAY, OCTOBER 30, 2017.**

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. The applicant must have financial need as demonstrated through the 2017-2018 FAST financial aid application.
2. The applicant must have a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 and be in good standing behaviorally.
3. Students of all levels are invited to apply.
4. The applicant must submit an essay using the prompt below. Essays must be no more than 300 words, typed in a 12-point font and double-spaced. Please do not put your name or any identifying information on your essay sheet. Please attach your essay response to this application page.

Essay Prompt: *The "Little Way" of St. Therese: St. Therese saw herself as a child of God. She liked to keep things simple and focused as a child does. She believed and teaches us that life presents enough challenges and opportunities for grace. She teaches us that God is everywhere - in every situation and person - and in the ordinary, simple details of life. Her "Little Way" teaches us to do the ordinary things of life with extraordinary love. A smile, a note of encouragement, a phone call, always having a positive word, a simple unnoticed task to brighten the life of another, and so many other simple deeds, done with love - these are the examples of her spirituality. The smallest action, done with love, is more important than great deeds done for personal glory, gratification or simply out of obedience.*
